If you ever wish to revoke it or make changes to it, you need to notify every person who received a copy. You can notify each person verbally or in writing. Providing the notification in a letter and keeping a copy for your records is the best way to protect yourself. You can also give them a copy of any revised advance directive which will automatically revoke the older version.
