The dLCV Public Awareness and Goals Committee met on 1/11/21, 2/26/21, and 3/19/21 this quarter. The purpose of the meetings was to plan and create the initial survey instrument and survey process for 2021, and have discussion about the next systemic partner survey instrument.

The Committee made a few changes to the previous year's survey instrument which included:

- 1) Changing the number of allowable important issue choices for respondents from 3 to 5
- 2) Changing the veteran status question to reflect active and veteran military members
- 3) Modifying a question about how COVID-19 impacted your life over the past year to give practical examples focused on disability advocacy

dLCV staff completed an early launch of the survey from 3/23/21-3/31/21 to specifically target clients and other individuals with disabilities. The survey opened to the general public the week of April 5th.

As Committee Member Sean Campbell manages the 2021 Chair responsibilities, Board Members Gavriel Legynd and Harry Gewanter agreed to begin the process to take the reins and co-chair the Committee through a transition process during the year.

The Committee will meet again to review survey data in June, finalize the recommendations to the Board for the FY 22 Goals and Focus Areas, and affirm the systemic partner survey instrument.
