

The Governing Board of Directors for the disAbility Law Center of Virginia has several openings for new members. The dLCV is a nonprofit organization, tasked with advancing the rights of people with disabilities throughout Virginia. dLCV operates with funding from stable federal grants along with some funding from private and corporate donors.

The Board is responsible for developing and monitoring operating policy, for providing fiscal oversight, for offering guidance on dLCV's program implementation, and for supporting the financial well-being of the organization.

The Board meets at least quarterly. Meetings are held in Richmond, Virginia at the dLCV office at 1512 Willow Lawn Drive and virtually as necessary. dLCV reimburses members for travel expenses related to the meetings. Directors also are expected to serve on one committee and/or in another capacity that assists with the functioning of the Board.

In 2022, the Board is seeking new members who are knowledgeable about disability issues and who represent the geographic and racial diversity of Virginia, especially applicants living in densely populated northern Virginia, and lower densely populated areas of southern Virginia and northwest area of the state (e.g., Shenandoah valley). The Board especially seeks members who are culturally, ethnically or linguistically diverse, as well as applicants who identify as having a developmental or intellectual disability and who can fulfill the duties of a Board member, with or without accommodations.
