


Your Top 4 Sex Education Rights

according to Virginia Code 22.1-207.1 and 22.1-217.03



You have the right to be educated on a **variety of sexual health information** including reproduction, prevention of sexual harassment, consent, sexually transmitted infections, and healthy relationships.

You have the right to receive education about **sexual health, self-restraint, self-protection, personal privacy, and setting and respecting personal boundaries.**

You have the right to **receive printed or audio-visual materials** on these subjects in the format you prefer.

You have the right for this **material to be included in your IEP** and have it be a part of your **continuing education.**

*Encourage your guardians to **opt you in** to sexual health education. You should **both** be involved in this decision.
