Know Your Rights

- The disAbility Law Center of Virginia (dLCV) is the designated protection and advocacy system for Virginians with disabilities
- People with disabilities should know about their right to vote
- To vote in person, find your polling place. You can go to:

- Have access to the polling place to vote
- Have a companion to assist you in the voting booth
- Request personal assistance from one of the voting assistants

What are the requirements to vote in Virginia?

 Register to vote in Virginia. You must register to vote. Go to this link:

https://www.elections.virginia.gov/registration/how -to-register/

- Be a citizen of the United States
- Be 18 years of age [or older]
- Not be registered or plan to vote in any other state
- Not be currently adjudicated mentally incompetent by a court
- If you were convicted of a felony, your right to vote must have been restored

Absentee Voting:

Apply for an absentee ballot. This allows you to vote by mail or in person before Election Day. You must sign in front of a witness on all ballots to be mailed.

To vote in person, find your polling place.

Curbside Voting:

If you have a physical disability or are 65 or older, you can also go to your polling place on Election Day to vote curbside. "Curbside voting "means voting from your car.
